## **Qualifications:**

- Monitor attendance of all Indian students
- Assists in the preparation of materials for Indian children
- Maintains awareness of goals and objectives of supervising teacher
- Assists in implementing the planned program to ensure Indian children needs are being met
- Provides information to teacher(s) concerning Native American culture
- Participates in and facilitates activities to improve culture awareness within the total school program
- Provides monthly cultural lessons to students through collaboration with administration, teachers, specialty teachers (Art, PE, Music)
- Individual supplement counseling/support when necessary
- Serve as a strong advocate/positive role model
- Maintains Monitor and collect Indian Education 506 forms
- Identify and recruit Indian children who have not completed their 506 form
- Works with Indian children in small groups per teacher or administrator request
- Assist with testing as needed
- Regularly meet with Program Coordinator to discuss concerns, ideas, and program goals
- Prepare and submit reports to Program Coordinator
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as assigned by supervisor
