## **Qualifications**:

- 1. Registered Nurse, currently licensed in North Carolina

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Provides leadership and assistance in the development, implementation and coordination of the local school health policies, procedures and programs.
- 2. Assures that policies, procedures and programs adhere to legal and regulatory statues and ethical standards of nursing practice. Updates and revises policies and procedures as needed.
- 3. Serves as school nurse of assigned school(s). Performs duties of School Nurse. See School Nurse Job Description.
- 4. Ensures and maintains record of school nurse's license renewals.
- 5. Evaluates school nurse's job performance in collaboration with the school principal.
- 6. Coordinates and conducts school nurse meetings.
- 7. Coordinates orientation and training of school nurses.
- 8. Coordinates mass hearing and vision screening program within Scotland County Schools.
- 9. Coordinates CPR/AED/FIRST AID training for first responders and maintains training records.
- 10. Serves as contact and coordinates the Bloodborne Pathogen training and implementation for school employees.
- 11. Coordinates the Scotland County School Health Advisory Council
- 12. Represents Scotland County Schools before various publics, including SCHD, EPI Team and SC Comm. Collaborative
- 13. Attends School Health Supervisor/Lead School Nurse meetings biannually with Regional School Nurse Consultant.
- 14. Completes the School Nursing End of Year Report and Wellness Report annually. Completes the Prevent Blindness Reports biannually.
