Have you registered your children for complimentary COVID-19 testing? In conjunction with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, South Johnson Elementary and Scotland County Schools is providing COVID-19 testing on site at our school(s). **In order for your student to participate in this free, StrongSchoolsNC COVID-19 testing, you will need to register your student.**



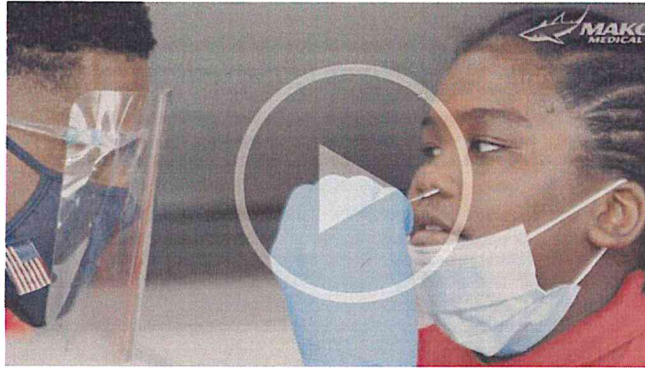

How it Works

A parent or guardian must register their child. You'll give a one-time consent and HIPAA authorization to share testing results with all necessary parties. All testing information is confidential and results will be available in hours. Your child will only be tested for COVID-19 if requested, if they are experiencing symptoms or have been considered close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Your child will not be tested without your consent and being informed prior to testing. At anytime, you may opt out of the testing program for your child.

Our school nursing staff will administer an anterior nares nasal swab test that is quick and gentle. (This is NOT the test that tickles the brain!) Check out this video to see our student testing in action.
